While listening at a recent SCVAC horn rehearsal, I was reminded of another time when the same Scott Pierson was polishing the music currently being played by the SCVAC. It was 32 years ago at a school in Santa Clara where Gail Royer taught music. The school was Jefferson Junior High on Monroe Street at Lawrence Expressway. The prevailing breeze came off the bay from the north and the Santa Clara Vanguard resonated through the neighborhood throughout the afternoon and into the evenings.

The shows of '67 through '71 were played at performance volume from that field. Strains of "Fiddler on the Roof" became familiar to those living downwind. Jefferson Junior High School was also the place where many tours started and ended.

As a member of the "B corps", I can recall greeting the corps as they returned home victorious in '71 after winning the VFW Nationals in Dallas. I recall some of us climbing onto the

busses after the members had unloaded and departed. Our average age was around 13 then and we were in awe of the artifacts of the tour, discarded or abandoned on the bus floor. I can recall collecting a few show programs that I still treasure today.

In 1972, a church was built on land that was directly south of the Jefferson practice field. That was the end of the Sunday rehearsal site as there were complaints about the noise. The next practice venue was Agnew Elementary. We were very loud and lost that school too. Both of those schools are gone now. The Jefferson site is now a business park where SCV Alumni Maureen Heckman has an office.

The SCVAC kicked off the season with a performance at the 35th Anniversary Spaghetti dinner March 10th. The SCVAA will sponsor our first "Casino Night" on Sunday evening, April 14th beginning at 6:00pm. Come join us, see some friends and have some fun!!
