**Job Type:** Temporary, Full-Time

**Who We Are Looking For:** The Santa Clara Vanguard (SCV) is seeking certified/licensed healthcare providers (athletic trainers, nurses, physical therapists, physicians, etc) to join the Health and Wellness Team for the upcoming 2020 season! Drum Corps can be a strenuous activity for our membership, but the SCV Health and Wellness team is dedicated to making their experience as comfortable and stress free as possible. We're looking for team players who are professional with a strong work ethic and attention to detail! In this role you will work closely with SCV staff and membership, reporting directly to the Head Athletic Trainer.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Travel with SCV throughout Spring Training and their summer tour; managing the day-to-day operations of the drum corps' medical needs
- Oversee the development and implementation of an athletic training program required for a drum corps including injury prevention programs, injury evaluations, injury management, injury treatment & rehabilitation, educational programs, and counseling for member-athletes
- Attend rehearsals throughout the day and be on call during show warm-ups in the event of an emergency. Serve as a first responder and evaluate various injuries and medical ailments and follow up as necessary
- Communicate with the Corps Director, Corps Manager, and Caption Managers on the status and recommendations for member health through daily written updates
- Responsible for administering medicine at all meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snack) as well as logging all medicine administered
- Assist with hydration procedures during rehearsal days and shows, communicating all water needs to the SCV Admin Team
- Responsible for inventory of medicine and first aid bags including member med bags, communicating all supply needs to the SCV Tour Manager

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- All applicants must be 22 years of age or older by May 15, 2020
- Medical Assistants will NOT be required to travel full-time on the road with SCV. Coverage schedules will be determined based on availability and organization needs. The summer tour schedule lasts from May 15 through August 8. Meals, lodging, and travel will be provided for individuals in this position
- Applicants are expected to work in a professional manner and possess strong interpersonal and communication skills (both written and verbal)
- At least one year of performance and/or administrative experience with a drum corps, winter guard, or winter percussion program is preferred

- Ability to multitask, take direction, and execute with precision
- Team-Player with excellent organizational and interpersonal skills
- Rapid learner with a positive attitude who thrives in a fast-paced environment
- Strong moral character and sense of integrity

**LICENSE & QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must be certified and/or licensed in accordance with appropriate state and national governing bodies
- An active driver license is preferred, however not required. All SCV staff with a valid driver's license may be added to VMAPA's insurance and will be allowed to operate company vehicles
- Must successfully complete a background check, conducted through a 3rd-party vendor
