



VMAPA HALL OF FAME – CRITERIA

The creation of the VMAPA Hall of Fame will help to perpetuate the memory of the special people who have brought honor to the Santa Clara Vanguard, and other programs of Vanguard Music and Performing Arts organization, and who can serve as role models for present and future generations. The VMAPA Hall of Fame will recognize outstanding performing members, staff, and volunteers that have contributed significantly to the Vanguard Music and Performing Arts organization.

Nominees must have made an outstanding contribution during their time participating with one of the VMAPA programs, or while serving with the organization as a whole. Examples include:

- Performing Members (Vanguard, Vanguard Cadets, Community Ensembles, etc.)
- Staff Members (educational staff, administrative staff, design staff, etc.)
- Volunteers (food crew, sewing crew, drivers, parents, etc.)
- Other significant contributors

Additionally, each nominee:

1. Exemplified character while representing Vanguard Music and Performing Arts as a performing member, staff member, or volunteer.
2. Continued to exemplify character as an alumni or patron.
3. Must be in good standing on all VMAPA membership dues.
4. Is a positive role model that current and future members will want to emulate.

This recognition is intended to enhance the tradition of our Vanguard Music and Performing Arts programs, and to motivate others to act with the same standards of excellence.

Criteria for nomination:

1. Former performing members who have excelled in their program and have been removed 5 years from performing.
2. Staff members who have made outstanding contributions to the organization.
3. Volunteers or community members who have made outstanding contributions to the organization.
4. Be in good standing with the organization and up to date on all membership dues.
5. Only individuals may be nominated, no groups may be nominated.
