



VMAPA HALL OF FAME – PROCEDURES

1. Only performing members, staff members, and volunteers of a Vanguard Music and Performing Arts program who served with the organization for one complete season may submit a completed nomination form to the VMAPA Hall of Fame Committee for consideration.
2. All nominations must be on file (submitted) by the last day of December each year. Nominations will remain on file for 3 years from the last nomination and after that time individuals must be re-nominated for consideration.
3. All nominees must be in alignment with organization values and in good standing with organizational financial obligations.
4. The people that are nominating individuals for consideration are responsible for informing those individuals of their nomination, and should gather information on their past achievements. They will be responsible for meeting the deadlines set by the VMAPA Hall of Fame Committee.
5. The VMAPA Hall of Fame will have a maximum of five inductees for the first two years, and all years thereafter will be a maximum of three inductees.
6. Once a person is inducted into the VMAPA Hall of Fame, that membership is for life.
7. Each inductee will receive a personalized Hall of Fame trophy, and his or her name will be placed on a plaque along with fellow HOF members of the same year to hang in the Vanguard Hall.
8. Each inductee will receive tickets to the VMAPA Birthday Celebration in March, and will enjoy special seating at all future VMAPA Birthday Celebrations.
